

EXPECTATIONS OF JUNIOR FIRE CREW TRAINING 2024

- On **Monday April 8 @ 16:00** please meet at the Fire Base located at the airport, 2783 Airport Way. You'll need to access the base through the airport gate. A unique code will be shared with you prior to your first scheduled meeting. There are currently 6 office trailers that serve as our base until a new facility is completed in a couple of years. Please park along the bank once you are through the gate.
- A base tour will be conducted April 8th, and it is expected that you will obey all the guidelines and boundaries discussed on the tour for the duration of your training.
- Closed toed shoes are always mandatory on the base. Steel toes are not required.
- For fitness testing (April 10th), there are no specific clothing requirements, but it is suggested that you wear something that you would normally work out in (runners, shorts etc.)
- Throughout the training you must wear closed toed shoes and clothing appropriate, and respectful for that daily training. We will try to incorporate some fitness whenever possible. Please have appropriate attire and footwear with you for each training session. If you are recovering from injury or unable to participate in fitness, please let and your instructors Stefan know ahead of time, this will NOT negatively impact your overall scoring. Our goal is to ensure that you are successful with our WFX Fit test and have some fun doing something other than just sitting in the classroom.
- Show up early (5 minutes is typical around the base), be ready to go by the designated time and be dressed accordingly for the activity. Any field course/practical components will require that you wear boots. You will be told in advance.
- Personal Protective Equipment (hearing, eyewear, gloves, hardhat) will be provided as necessary.
- If you know that you will not be able to attend a particular course/date then it is your responsibility to inform Stefan as to what course you will be missing and the reason for not being able to attend (if something comes up last minute, the base number has been given below and a message left here will be suitable). You will be required to get the required learning material.
- This experience is to be considered a very long interview process, and as such I cannot stress enough the importance of attendance. Failure to attend more than two classes without prior notice will prompt a discussion with Mr. Ostoforov, and the base manager Quintin Balfour, and possibly be the termination of your participation in the training and opportunity all together.
- Participate fully in all activities unless you have clearly outlined why you cannot.
